On the other hand, the student is overwhelmed by the extensive body of knowledge that must be integrated and applied to evaluate each patient's general and oral health status and to plan appropriate treatment.

Several subjects contribute to dental diagnostic decisions such as oral pathology and internal medicine. Students need an introductory correlation of this information as it relates to the clinical diagnostic process.
